Checks should be made out to Dumont Recreation.

Businesses promoting their company only, will be asked to have a free activity at their booth. All booth spaces will be approximately 10' x 12'. Each space will come with 2 six foot tables and 2 chairs. Participants may not bring in their own tables or chairs. Participants may bring their own tents. The tents must be in "like new" condition and must fit within the booth space. Tents will also be available for rental through Traditional Events on a first come first serve basis. The rental fee for the tents is \$50,00.

All involved, with the exception of those promoting their businesses only, will be able to charge for booth activities. Activities will be of a family friendly nature i.e. Games, raffles, food & rides. No vendors or organizations will be allowed to sell candy cigarettes, toy guns, confetti, silly string, poppers or whips. Traditional Events must approve activities according to Borough guidelines. There will be no exceptions and no repeat activities/food allowed. This will allow each group to fund raise equally.



Raffle licenses must be obtained through the borough and must be event specific. Multiple groups wishing to hold a 50/50 raffle will be allowed. All raffle licenses must be applied for by Friday, July 28, 2017 for inclusion at Dumont Day. There will be no exceptions.

STAGE:

Local dance, karate, bands, choral groups, etc. will be invited to participate on the stage and given 15 - 30 minute time slots to work within. All other time slots will be filled through activities that local businesses have sponsored.

REQUIREMENTS FOR TEMPORARY FOOD EVENTS

Approval for temporary food events will not be given unless the following requirements are met. The attached application must be submitted to the Health Department prior to the event.

- All preparation must comply with NJAC 8:24. Equipment used for transport and storage (coolers, etc.) must be clean and in good repair. Foods must be obtained from an approved source.
 - ***Home prepared foods are prohibited (receipts must be provided)***
- Proper food temperatures must be maintained at ALL times. (This includes during transport, on display, and in storage.)
 - o Cold foods must be 41° F or below
 - o Hot foods must be 135° F or above
- Potentially hazardous foods that require re-heating must be cooked to 165° F; and if hot held, must be held at 135° F or above. Sternos, steam tables or other hot-holding equipment may not be used to reheat potentially hazardous foods.
- The following thermometers are needed:
 - o A food testing/probe thermometer for cooked foods.
 - o Refrigeration thermometer for cold-holding units (sufficient supply of ice needed)
- · Method for hand-washing or hand-sanitizing available.
 - o If running water for hand-washing is available, soap and paper towels must be provided.
 - o If access to running water unavailable, hand sanitizers must be provided.
- Bare hand contact with ready-to-eat foods <u>must be eliminated</u>. The use of gloves, tongs, deli tissue, etc. must be utilized. If gloves are used, they must be properly changed in between activities (i.e. handing raw meats, ready-to-eat foods, soiled equipment/utensils, smoking, eating/drinking, handling money, etc.) Separate utensils must be utilized for raw foods and ready-to-eat foods.
- Wash, Rinse, and Sanitize Method needed for utensils, pots, etc.
 - o If access to running water unavailable, the following method may be used:
 - Set up three buckets or large containers. Fill the first with soap and water. Fill the second with water only. Fill the third with bleach and water (50-100 ppm / one half ounce bleach per gallon of water.)
 - Wash item in the first bucket, rinse it off in the second, dip it in the third bucket for one minute, and allow to air dry.
- All items must be off the ground and protected (food, beverages, utensils, etc.)

THE LICENSE APPLICATION AND YOUR SPECIFIC MENU ITEMS MUST BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO THE EVENT.
