Call to Order: 7:30pm Tanya/Rachel

1. Review and approve prior meeting minutes from May 15, 2023 accepted: Rachel/Tom
2. Swearing in of new commissioners Councilman John Russell swore in Stephanie Petriello and Sasha Attanasio as DSTC commissioners. We now have a full slate of seven commissioners including: Tanya Zimmerman, Rachel Bunin, Tom Fisichella, Sally Tayeb, Wayne Cahilly
3. Arboretum Water Feature Pump: Rex explained how the pump is no longer working and out of warranty (was a 5 yr. warranty) pump should have lasted 20 years. But didn't, it seized. Not sure why that happened but a new pump needed for summer. Sally made motion to pay for new pump from FOTST funds. \$600+ Tom F will look and try to 'fix' current pump. If not able, we will buy a new one.
4. Tree Removals on List/Risk Assessment Plan and Inclusion of Sidewalk Remediation List of 16 critical trees; Tanya read responses from Dennis, Jeanine re: status. Estimated 1/week and have started to remove. 84 Andover one of the first to go. Discussion on removing sidewalks where trees are an issue and homeowner cannot pay to replace. Tanya will run idea by borough engineer. Public safety is our first priority.
5. Homeowner Issues/Borough Tree Issues Sally explained how many trees net loss over 15 years in boro. Looking for grants to plant trees. Adopt-a-Tree program not keeping up with loss.

Rachel will contact CVS management to see if they would plant in area by parking lot at Veterans Plaza

Veronica mentioned need to plant evergreens in Memorial Park. Also 20 pocket parks in borough need trees

Dead trees on Blauvelt/Howard and Depew need to come down. DPW to be notified.
6. Davies Tree Survey—update needed. Started on June 12 Survey has started. Training session will include Rachel, Stephanie and we want to include Cathy Romeo. Date TBD
7. Monthly Arboretum Inspections—Sally—June Sally's report is in Excel, very detailed. Future reporting will use same spreadsheet but saved as a Google Sheet so all can share and see if issues were attended to. DPW is aware that the gazebo needs maintenance and staining

Motion to remove dead rose bushes. Discussion on status of roses, some dead, some may survive with treatment. Tanya will contact Davis Johnson Garden rose caretaker to see what to do. All in favor of removing dead bushes and replacing with native, low maintenance perennials,
