23 Wolcott- Neighbor damaged a private tree; told we don't have jurisdiction over private trees but advised

48 Shelby: Tree inspected. Evaluated as OK. Will reevaluate and remove ivy to give it a chance to recover. Done before and worked to improve another tree.

205 East Madison: Tom evaluated. Not a boro tree; there is a big branch to be removed

234 Sunset: on Medford and Sunset: Buyer needs a CO (there were questions about who gets the CO) Needs to fix sidewalk. It's a big maple tree. DSTC doesn't fix sidewalks; in code that homeowners fix sidewalks.

?? White Beeches: Homeowner tree. Ms. Hanna chain-link fences is by softball field. Oak Tree covered in Ivy (some maybe poison ivy) Heritage tree in right of way

Woodside Cemetery: branch still hanging; have to find the trustees who should remove branch.

Colonial Parkway: owners topped trees... we agree terrible but it's their tree. sadly, cut all limbs

Twitter and Instagram gaining followers and posts. FB going well for events and LIKES Abbie has archived and reorganized the website to improve usability.



Bed 6 rosebush was hit by a car but Bill Z tied it up and thinks it will recover. Minor damage to lights in gazebo have been fixed. Gale Ferrer will decorate for the holidays. We now have fall corn stalks in gazebo.

Visions FCU agreed to pay for Mulch (getting from Tony Lupardi who has been a great supporter and partner for the arboretum)

Education

Honiss School program; Deforestation and local impact.

We agreed they can invite parents. About 160 6th graders for program

Sally has a booklet to hand out.

We'll have several stations with interactive set up for kids to see Deforestation effects Also, we have a large photo of the bench to show.

Tree Nursery Project

We are "moving on it" Ray has a proposal ready to go. Handed out.

Ray met with Rec and soon we will break ground in October. Trees in pots. Starting with 20' x 100' but can grow.

When he gets the go-ahead we will have a 'ceremony' and invite the TBN and NJ.com and www.northjerseyinmotion.com

Can be a give and take, we'll have a tree rescue farm.

Need to figure out watering and fund raising- solicit donations and find ways to collect rainwater.

Regular Business Tree Maintenance

Tom report: we are a little behind but ok. Mostly private trees coming in and town trees are a simple remove for many reported. Most disputes are between neighbors. Some trees look dead but aren't. Leaf drop on Maples/Apples/Sycamores.

Black fungus on 2 maples and Beech. Took a sample and sending to Rutgers to analyze.

Dennis the tree guy is doing a great job. We agreed that the commissioners should try to meet him.

128 Manhattan Terrace: Owner has reported again the tree. It was cabled a few years (?) back, and deemed safe on recent reinspection (arborist went up in bucket and evaluated)

61 Howard: Beautiful healthy 80' Oak is in the owner's driveway. Tom and Ray working on solution and evaluating situation.

Tom will submit a quarterly report by end of September.
