AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DUMONT, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 75-6 POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE DUMONT CODE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined to revise the police department hiring policy in order to expedite the process that permits the Dumont Police Department to hire experienced, working police officers who have already completed their training and probationary service in another police department; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council now seek to accommodate that determination by

supplementing the rigorous standards and requirements for new police recruits and hires on the Borough force; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend this section of Chapter 75 of the Borough Code governing the required process for police promotions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Dumont, in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 75-6(H) SELECTION PROCESS of the Borough of Dumont Code shall be amended to include the new language hereinafter provided:

Chapter 75-6 (H) Selection Process.

(2) The Dumont Police Department may alternatively consider hiring police officers who have completed, or are more than halfway through the Alternate Route Program, or are currently employed by another municipal, county, or state police agency. Such a candidate, having already participated in a process comparable to the selection process described in Chapter 75-6(H)(1), having previously graduated from an accredited police academy, having completed his or her period of probationary police service as a member of a municipal, county, or state police department and having already demonstrated his or her qualifications to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, may, at the discretion of the Chief of the Dumont Police Department, proceed through an expedited selection process. Upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police, and the concurrence of a majority of the governing body, such officer shall be hired as a Dumont Police Officer, on salary terms and conditions to be determined by negotiation with the Chief of Police and Dumont Council Police Committee.

Invalidity. If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

Severability. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. In the event of a conflict with any prior enactment, the provisions hereof shall prevail.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication

pursuant to law.

BOROUGH OF DUMONT BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

CALENDAR YEAR 2017 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A:4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to .5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by

ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Dumont in the County of Bergen finds its advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2017 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$489,943 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Dumont, in the County of Bergen, a majority of the full authorized membership of this Governing Body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2017 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Dumont shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14, be increased by 3.0%, amounting to \$489,943, and that the CY 2017 municipal budget for the Borough of Dumont be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption
