An Ordinance of the Borough of Dumont, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 455 OF THE DUMONT BOROUGH CODE
TO INCLUDE DEFINITIONS RELATING TO PERVIOUS DRIVEWAY SURFACES
AND PERVIOUS SURFACES**

WHEREAS, the Borough Code of the Borough of Dumont regulates residential driveways; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Code of the Borough of Dumont sets forth definitions of phrases used in certain code provisions; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that such definitions be as specific and inclusive as possible; and

WHEREAS, definitions relating to pervious driveway surfaces and pervious surfaces would provide greater clarity to the Borough Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Dumont, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Dumont are hereby amended by the addition of the following definitions to §455-5 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Dumont, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey:

PERVIOUS DRIVEWAY SURFACE a surface that will permit surface water to pass through the surface and provide a durable driveway surface. (See §455-17T, Off-street parking, Driveways – Residential for more information).

PERVIOUS SURFACE – a surface that will permit surface water to pass through the surface, resulting in minimal run-off to abutting streets, sidewalks, swales, and ditches.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
