RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROVISIONAL APPOINTMENT OF BONNIE SWITZER, CMCA, AS ACTING MUNICIPAL COURT ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, via a Memorandum from the Superior Court of New Jersey, the Borough's Municipal Court Administrator, Judge and Mayor were notified that the Borough is now required to appoint, on a provisional basis, an Acting Municipal Court Administrator to undertake court duties when the Dumont Municipal Court Administrator is out on a scheduled and/or unscheduled leave of absence (copy attached, EXHIBIT A); and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Court Administrator has recommended that Dumont enter into an agreement with the Borough of Closter and provisionally appoint Bonnie Switzer, CMCA, as Acting Municipal Court Administrator; and

WHEREAS, a Consent and Agreement is required to be prepared, executed and forwarded to the Superior Court's representative on or before January 16, 2017 (see sample, EXHIBIT A); and

WHEREAS, an Order of Provisional Authority must be prepared, signed by the Municipal Court Judge and insurance/bonding must be certified by the Administrator; the fully completed Order must be forwarded to the Superior Court's representative on or before January 16, 2017; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Dumont, Bergen County, as follows:

- 1. The Borough Attorney is hereby authorized to prepare the Consent and Agreement (or review same if prepared by the Dumont attorney), the Order of Provisional Authority and any other necessary documents.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Consent and Agreement and any other documents necessary to implement this appointment.
- 3. The Municipal Court Judge is hereby authorized to execute the aforementioned Order, subject to his approval of same.
- 4. The Borough Administrator is hereby authorized to execute the aforementioned Order, subject to verification that the acting municipal court administrator has been bonded or insured by the Borough.
- 5. The Borough Administrator shall forward a fully executed copy of the Order and Agreement to Brendis Montijo-Wrigley, Municipal Division Manager, Bergen County Superior Court, 10 Main Street, Hackensack, NJ 07601 no later than January 16, 2017.
- 6. The Borough Clerk shall forward a copy of this Resolution to the Dumont Municipal Court Administrator and the Closter Borough Clerk and Municipal Court Administrator.

AUTHORIZATION OF COMMERCIAL APPRAISAL AND LITIGATION SUPPORT SERVICES OF McNERNEY & ASSOCIATES

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Dumont require the services of an appraisal professional to assist in defending tax appeals on behalf of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it becomes necessary to prepare specific property appraisals to justify the assessed value in court proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's duly appointed property appraiser, McNerney & Associates, is unable due to a professional conflict, to prepare the required appraisal in the matter of White Beeches Country Club v. Borough of Dumont, and the services of a substitute appraiser being

required, and

WHEREAS, on the recommendation of tax appeal counsel, and in consideration of the fact that the Boroughs of Haworth and Oradell, comprising responsibility for over 84% of the assessed property of the tax paying entity, have previously engaged Mark E. Hendricks, CRE, of Real Estate Appraisals and Research, to prepare the necessary appraisals, and the Council concurring and seeking to authorize said proposal.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Governing Body of the Borough of Dumont, authorizes the preparation of a commercial property appraisal in the above captioned matter by Mark E. Hendricks, CRE, of Real Estate Appraisals and Research Appraisers, for tax years 2013-2014 and 2015-2016 in the amount of \$2,916.50, pro rated at 15.76% of the financial obligation, consistent with the acreage of the taxpayer situated in the Borough of Dumont and additional litigation support as required to be authorized only on further action of the Borough Council, subject to certification of available funds by the Chief Financial Officer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, copies of this resolution shall be provided to the Appraiser, Tax Appeal Counsel, Assessor, Municipal Clerks of Haworth and Oradell and the CFO.
