NICHOLAS M. FOGLIO-HIRE AS DUMONT POLICE OFFICER

WHEREAS, Resolution #126 was approved authorizing the hiring of a new Police Officer; and

WHEREAS, Resolution #126 was in compliance with the provisions of Borough Ordinance #1500; and

WHEREAS, applicants took a physical fitness exam administered by Dr. Michael W. Golz, DC of Ramsey Sport Spine; and

WHEREAS, applicants were required to take a written exam administered by Chief Nally of the New Jersey Association of Chiefs of Police; and

WHEREAS, applicants were interviewed in an Agency Oral Interview administered by Chief Conner (Dumont PD) with the assistance of Capt. McKeary (Dumont PD) Chief Robert Chamberlain (Tenafly PD) and Chief Michael Gracey (Haworth PD).

WHEREAS, applicants were also interviewed in a Police Agency/Police Committee Oral Interview administered by Chief Conner (Dumont PD), Capt. McKeary (Dumont PD), and Lt. Centrello (Dumont PD) in conjunction with the Police Committee consisting of Councilman Morrell, Councilman Manna, and Councilwoman Correa; and

WHEREAS, the top performers in this hiring process were ranked highest score to lowest with applicants not passing various aspects of the test being eliminated during the process; and

WHEREAS, based on the combined scores, a list was established ranking the applicants highest to lowest in overall score; and

WHEREAS, the applicant scoring the highest combined overall grade in the above-mentioned process was Nicholas M. Foglio.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Governing Body of the Borough of Dumont authorizes the hiring of Nicholas M. Foglio as a Police Officer in the Dumont Police Department as of July 1, 2017;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Mr. Foglio's hiring would be contingent upon him passing a background investigation, physical examination, psychological examination and academy training at the Bergen County Law and Public Safety Institute;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, once graduated from the Academy, Nicholas would be a probationary officer for a period of up to eighteen months.
