#### OPPOSITION TO PRIVATIZATION OF AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is a national authority with the powers to regulate all aspects of civil aviation including the construction and operation of airports, the certification of personnel and aircraft, and air traffic management; and

WHEREAS, air traffic control (ATC) is a service provided by ground-based air traffic controllers who direct aircraft on the ground and through controlled airspace for the primary purpose to prevent collisions, organize and expedite the flow of air traffic, and provide information and other support for pilots; and

WHEREAS, the FAA's air traffic control functions oversee the largest aviation system in the world, including flights that carry over two million passengers each day on 65,000 flight, and air

traffic control functions necessary to maintain the high level of aviation safety in the United States aviation; and

WHEREAS, legislation has been introduced in the United State House of Representatives at the urging of the major airline companies to remove Congressional oversight of the FAA and air traffic control and place it under the purview of a private board of aviation industry stakeholders; and

WHEREAS, the four major airlines, which already control 70 percent of the United States commercial aviation market share, would command an outsized presence on this board allowing them to solidify their control of the market and further shut out low cost and mid-sized airline companies at a cost to consumers; and

WHEREAS, Newark Liberty International Airport remains the most expensive airport for consumers in the nation due to the lack of low cost competition; and

WHEREAS, a privatized system would allow the major airlines free reign to raise fees and institute new taxes, further cut essential routes and shrink seats and leg room and in 2016 alone, the United States Department of Transportation received over 20,000 complaints about the major airlines and travelers continue to face endless, often deceptive, fees totaling \$6.8 billion; and

WHEREAS, as Congress considers these issues and more, we must remember that public airspace should always be operated for the benefit of the public, rather then the benefit of corporate interests; and

NOW THEREFORE IT BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Dumont opposes any effort to privatize the Federal Aviation Administration in its facilitation of air traffic control; and

**NOW THEREFORE IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED**, copies of this resolution will be sent to Representative Josh Gottheimer of the New Jersey 5<sup>th</sup> Congressional District.

## APPROVAL OF HIRING CUMMING FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Borough of Dumont to hire a Construction Management firm to provide expertise for the construction of the new municipal complex; and

WHEREAS, RFQ's for Construction Management Services were advertised; and

WHEREAS, the fee for the Pre-Construction Phase is \$120,000, the fee for Construction is \$264,000 and the fee for closeout is \$5,000-a total of \$389,000, these figures being contingent upon the architect's final design;
