BE IT RESOLVED, the Governing Body of the Borough of Dumont hereby authorizes the execution of the contract for Chief Michael J. Conner.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made this day of January, 2018, by and between the BOROUGH OF DUMONT, a body politic and corporate of the State of New Jersey, hereafter referred to as the "Employer" or the "Borough," and DUMONT POLICE CHIEF MICHAEL J. CONNER, hereinafter referred to as the "Chief;"

WHEREAS, the Employer and the Chief recognize that it will be to the benefit of both to promote mutual understanding and foster a harmonious relationship between the parties to the end that continuous and efficient service will be rendered to and by both parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

PRESERVATION OF RIGHTS

The Employer hereby retains and reserves unto itself all powers, rights, authority, duties and responsibilities conferred upon and vested in it prior to the signing of this Agreement by the laws and Constitution of the State of New Jersey, including, but without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the following rights:

- (a) To the executive management and administrative control of the Employer Government and its properties and facilities;
- (b) To hire all employees, and subject to the provisions of law, to determine their qualifications and conditions for continued employment or assignment and to promote employees;
- (c) To suspend, promote, demote, transfer, assign, reassign, discharge, or take any other disciplinary action for good and just cause according to law.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed to deny or restrict the Employer or the Chief of their rights, responsibilities, and authority, under N.J.S. Titles 11, 34, 40 and 40A, or any other national, state, county or other applicable laws.

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STATUS AND DUTIES OF CHIEF

The Employer and the Chief hereby agree that the Chief is a "Managerial Executive" and "Executive Employee" for the purposes of N.J.S.A. 34:13A-1 et seq, as amended, the New Jersey Public Employer-Employee Relations Act and 29 U.S.C. section 213, the United States Fair Labor Standards Act, respectively, and companion or similar statutes and regulations.

The Chief shall devote his full time to carrying out the duties of his office and position subject to review and approval of the Mayor and Council and shall devote his best efforts to the accomplishment of his duties and the mission of the Dumont Police Department ("Department"). Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Chief from engaging in any outside activities which do not, in the opinion of the Mayor and Council, unreasonably interfere with his duties as Chief of Police. The Chief shall at all times present a professional demeanor and without prejudice, malice or unlawful discrimination, carry out his lawful duties to enforce the Constitutions of the United States and the State of New Jersey, the laws of the State of New Jersey and the ordinances of the County of Bergen and the Borough of Dumont.

The Chief shall have the authority to:

- a) Conduct and manage the day-to-day operations of the Department;
- b) Administer and enforce rules, regulations and special emergency directives regarding the disposition and discipline of the police force, its officers, and personnel;
- c) Have, exercise, and discharge the functions, powers, and duties of the police force;
- d) Delegate such of his authority as he may deem necessary for the efficient operation of the force to be exercised under his direction and supervision;
- e) Prescribe the duties and assignments of all subordinates and other personnel; and
- f) Report to the Borough regarding the operations of the Department at least monthly at the regular meeting(s) of the Borough's governing body or by any other such method the Borough shall require.

SALARY

As of the date of the commencement of this Agreement, the Chief is entitled to receive a base salary of \$160,097.00. For the term of this Agreement, the Chief shall receive an annual 1.85% increase in his base pay. This increase is based on, but is not tied to, the now existing PBA contract and Chapter 75 of the Borough's Code, and is set forth in this Agreement in light of the possibility that the PBA contract and Chapter 75 could be changed after the date of this Agreement to the Chief's detriment. In addition to the foregoing, for the term of this Agreement the Chief is also entitled to another annual 1% increase over and above the foregoing annual 1.85% increase, with this latter 1% increase taking place in light of Chapter 75 of the Borough's Code as it now exists, though here as well this latter increase is not tied to Chapter 75, since Chapter 75 is also subject to change after the date of this Agreement.

LONGEVITY

In addition to the wages and other compensation set forth in this Agreement the Chief shall be entitled to an annual longevity payment, which shall be equal to twelve percent (12%) of his base salary for that year. These longevity payments shall be parsed out over the course of the calendar year, with the pro-rated portion of this annual payment included as part of the Chief's regular, bi-weekly paycheck.

VACATION

The Chief shall receive forty (40) vacation days annually. Vacation time accrued but not voluntarily taken shall not accumulate beyond the calendar year in which it accrues. The Chief shall be entitled to additional compensation on an annual basis for all unused vacation days from that calendar year.

The Chief shall be entitled to schedule his own vacation time, provided that the Chief shall not take vacation leave unless subordinates are available to assume control of, and responsibility for, the operation of the Department. In addition, the Chief shall not

schedule his vacation time during any time period where planned events shall require the presence of the Chief.

HOLIDAYS

The below listed thirteen (13) holidays shall be included in the Chief's base salary as outlined above.

New Year's Day Good Friday Independence Day Columbus Day Lincoln's Birthday Veteran's Day Christmas Day Martin Luther King Day Memorial Day Labor Day Washington's Birthday Thanksgiving Day Election Day

On the holidays listed in this section the Chief shall not be expected to report for duty. In the event the Chief is required to report for duty on a holiday he shall be granted additional compensation for such hours as he may work on the holiday as follows. The amount of additional compensation to which the Chief is entitled when working on a holiday shall be calculated by multiplying the amount of hours the Chief worked on the given holiday by his hourly rate of pay. The Chief's hourly rate of pay shall be his then existing annual base salary divided by 2,080. Payment for the additional hours worked by the Chief on a holiday shall be included in the Chief's paycheck for the next pay period.

When any of these holidays shall occur on a Saturday, the holiday shall be observed on the Friday immediately preceding such Saturday. When any of these holidays shall occur on a Sunday, the holiday shall be observed on the Monday immediately following such Sunday.

OVERTIME

Under no circumstance shall the Chief receive overtime.

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TERMINAL LEAVE

In accordance with Chapter 75 of the Borough's Code as now in effect, the Chief shall be entitled to six months' terminal leave pay. Any change to Chapter 75 after the date of this Agreement shall be disregarded for purposes of this provision.

PERSONAL DAYS

The Chief shall receive three (3) personal days annually without loss of pay in addition to any other time off provided for in this Agreement. Any personal days unused in a given year shall be lost, and will not accumulate from year to year.

Personal days shall be utilized for personal, business, household, or family matters. For the purposes of this Agreement "business" means an activity that requires the presence of the Chief during the workday and is of such a nature that it cannot be attended to at a time outside of the workday. For the purposes of this Agreement "personal," "household," and "family," refer to matters when the Chief's absence from duty is necessary for the welfare of the Chief or his family.

BEREAVEMENT LEAVE

In the event of a death in the Chief's immediate family (herein defined as including a spouse, parent, step-parent, grandparent, sibling, child, foster child, step-child, grandchild, parent-in-law, daughter-in-law, or son-in-law) or any other relatives residing the Chief's home, the Chief shall be granted time off, without loss of pay, commencing no later than the day of the funeral, but in no event to exceed three (3) consecutive calendar days.

SICK DAYS

Sick leave shall be defined to mean any absence due to illness, accident, injury, disability, exposure to contagious disease, or the necessity to attend to and care for a

seriously ill member of the Chief's immediate family. For the purposes of this agreement the term "immediate family" shall include the Chief's spouse, parent, child, step-parent, foster child, or any other relative residing in the Chief's household. In the event the Chief requires leave due to any of the reasons set forth in this paragraph, such leave shall be deemed sick leave with pay under this Agreement. Sick leave shall not be permitted to excuse absence caused by other employment or outside business ventures.

The Chief shall be entitled to sick leave in the amount of fifteen (15) days per calendar year. In the event the Chief is absent from work on sick leave for three (3) or more consecutive work days, the Borough may require the Chief to submit acceptable medical evidence substantiating the need for sick leave; or alternatively, may require a physician of its own choosing to provide a medical statement concerning the need for sick leave. Sick leave not used during the year in which it accrues shall be forfeit, and shall not accumulate from year to year.

OPTION FOR ANNUAL PAYMENT FOR ACCUMULATED LEAVE

The Chief shall be permitted to receive supplemental compensation once per year in exchange for forfeiting up to ten (10) accumulated vacation or sick days. These days will be paid out at the Chief's daily rate of pay at the time of payment. The Chief shall notify the Borough of his intention to cash out accumulated leave days, and if so in what amount, on or before December 1 of each year. The supplemental compensation paid pursuant to this section shall be included in the Chief's first paycheck of the following year.

WORK SCHEDULE

The Chief of Police shall spend sufficient time at his job to insure the orderly and responsible operation of the Department; which shall include a minimum of forty (40) hours worked per week. As noted *supra*, the Chief is a managerial employee, and thus not entitled to overtime compensation for hours worked in excess of forty (40) per week.

The Chief shall be permitted to utilize various forms of leave time as set forth in this Agreement.

CLOTHING ALLOWANCE

The Chief shall receive an annual clothing allowance in the amount of \$900.00, which shall be payable the first pay period in May. This amount shall be less all applicable deductions. If the Employer decides to change the uniform or any part thereof, it shall provide any such changed items to the Chief free of charge.

The Borough shall replace any clothing or personal items damaged or destroyed in the line of duty, or reimburse the Chief for the cost of replacing such items, provided reasonable replacement costs are mutually agreed to between the Borough and Chief.

It shall be left to the professional discretion of the Chief as to when he should wear a formal or informal uniform, or plain clothes.

INSURANCE AND DEATH BENEFITS

Except as otherwise stated herein, prior to retirement the Chief shall receive the same medical coverage provided to police officers pursuant to Article XXVII of the collective negotiations agreement between the Borough and the Dumont PBA Local 377 in force on the effective date of this Agreement. Accordingly, all of the provisions of the foregoing Article XXVII are hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth at length herein. The foregoing medical coverage includes full medical coverage for the Chief's spouse.

Similarly, during the term of this Agreement, prior to retirement the Chief shall contribute towards the provision of health insurance benefits provided by the Borough in the same amount as the members of the Union under the collective negotiations agreement between the Borough and the Dumont PBA Local 377 in force on the effective date of this Agreement. Accordingly, all of the terms of the foregoing agreement relating to the contribution towards the provision of health insurance benefits provided by the Borough are hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth at length herein. The

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foregoing provision of health insurance benefits provided by the Borough includes full health insurance benefits for the Chief's spouse.

Additionally, except as otherwise stated herein prior to retirement, the Chief shall receive the same life insurance benefits as those provided to police officers pursuant to Article XXVIII of the collective negotiations agreement between the Borough and the Dumont PBA Local 377 in force on the effective date of this Agreement. Accordingly, all of the provisions of the foregoing Article XXVIII are hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth at length herein.

Significantly, the incorporation by reference noted in the three immediately preceding paragraphs takes place in light of the fact that the Chief, by virtue of his status as a Managerial Executive (see above, page 2), is not a member of Dumont PBA Local 377 and has no say with regard to any changes to the version of the collective negotiations agreement between the Borough and the Dumont PBA Local 377 in force on the effective date of this Agreement that may take place after the effective date of this Agreement.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS/LAW ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCES

The Chief shall be permitted to attend and be compensated for, at his regular salary, any school, seminar, or training session conducted or sponsored by the International Association of Chiefs of Police, New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police, New Jersey State Police, Federal Bureau of Investigations, or any other education program of a management or supervisory nature. All expenses such as travel, room, food, tuition, special clothing, books, or any other charges connected with the educational program shall be borne by the Borough. The expenditures incurred in connection with the Chief's attendance at any of the above-referenced educational programs shall not exceed \$500, unless expressly permitted by the Borough. In no event shall the Borough be required to pay or reimburse the Chief for expenses of any class, course, school, or educational program unrelated to police activities.

The Borough agrees to grant the Chief the necessary paid leave, including travel time, for the Chief to attend any two (2) of: (1) the annual New Jersey State Association

of Chiefs of Police Conference; or (2) the annual International Association of Chiefs of Police Conference; or (3) the New Jersey League of Municipalities Conference. If the Chief of Police attends a conference at the Borough's expense, the Chief of Police shall provide the Borough with proof of expenses for attending such conference, by way of receipts or vouchers. The Chief of Police may also be required to provide a written report to the Mayor and Council which details the information presented at the conference. The expenditures incurred in connection with the Chief's attendance at any of the above-referenced conferences shall not exceed \$500, unless expressly permitted by the Borough.

The Borough also agrees to pay for the Chief of Police's dues for membership in the Bergen County Police Chiefs' Association, the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police, the International Association of Chiefs of Police and the F.B.I. National Academy Associates. The total amount of membership dues shall not exceed \$500, unless authorized in writing by the Borough.

WORK INCURRED INJURY

If the Chief suffers a work-connected injury or disability, the Employer shall continue the Chief at full pay, during the continuance of the Chief's inability to work, for a period of up to one (1) year. During this period of time, all temporary disability benefits accruing under the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Act shall be paid over to the Employer.

When injured while working, regardless of the severity of such injury, the Chief shall make an immediate report of such injury, if practicable, prior to the end of the workday on which the injury occurred. Failure to timely report any work incurred injury may result in the failure of the Chief to receive compensation for same under this Agreement,

The Chief shall be required to present evidence by a certificate of a responsible physician that he is unable to work and the Employer may reasonably require the Chief to present such certificate from time to time. The Employer may, at its discretion, require a certificate of inability to work from a physician selected by the Employer.

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In the event that the Chief contends that he is entitled to a period of disability beyond the period established by the treating physician, or a physician employed by the Employer or by its insurance carrier, the burden shall be upon the Chief to establish such additional period of disability by obtaining a judgment in the Division of Workmen's Compensation or, by the final decision of the last reviewing court which shall be binding upon both parties.

For the purpose of this Article, injury or illness occurred while the Chief is acting in an Employer-authorized activity shall be considered in the line of duty.

In the event that a dispute arises as to whether an absence shall be computed or designated as sick leave or an injury on duty, the parties agree to be bound by the decision of an appropriate Workmen's Compensation judgment, or, if there is an appeal therefrom, the final decision of the last reviewing court.

An injury on duty requiring time off for treatment, recuperation or rehabilitation shall not be construed as sick leave or sick leave occasion under the terms of the sick leave policy heretofore agreed upon between the parties.

In the event the Chief is granted injury leave, the Borough's sole obligation shall be to pay the Chief the difference between his regular pay and any compensation, disability, or other payments received from other sources.

PERSONAL CAR

The Borough agrees to supply the Chief with an unmarked automobile to be used for police work and for his personal use. The make and model of the automobile shall be determined by the Borough; provided that such automobile must be a full-sized, four-door vehicle equipped with such equipment as is necessary for police work.

The Chief shall be permitted to use the car for personal use. There shall be no limit on the use of the automobile for police work or anything associated with police work, such as attending meetings, school outings, trips, conferences, and any other traveling needed to carry out the Chief's official duties.

The Borough shall pay all expenses associated with the operation and upkeep of the automobile, including car insurance, tires, gas, oil changes, and any other necessary

repairs; except that the Chief shall be responsible for the cost of gasoline expended when the Chief is using the automobile for personal use.

The automobile shall not be used by anyone other than the Chief, except that the Chief may designate other members of the Department, as appropriate, to use the vehicle for a designated police purpose.

DISCHARGE AND DISCIPLINE

The Employer may discharge or discipline the Chief for any lawful reason, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-147 et seq, Borough Ordinances or any other statute, regulation, or source of law of the State of New Jersey. The Chief may obtain review of such action by the Employer in accordance with Borough Ordinances and N.J.S.A. 40A:14-150 et seq.

LEGAL DEFENSE

The Employer shall provide the Chief with all necessary legal advice and counsel in defense of any changes filed against him in connection with his performance of his duties in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey and the United States of America. The selection of an attorney may be made by the Chief, subject to the approval of the Borough, which shall not be unreasonably withheld. The Borough shall additionally indemnify the Chief in connection with all claims, including for compensatory and punitive damages and attorneys fees incurred by the Chief, for actions filed against the Chief in his official capacity subsequent to the expiration of this Agreement.

MEDICAL BENEFITS UPON RETIREMENT

Effective immediately upon MICHAEL J. CONNER's retirement as Chief, the Borough, at its sole cost and expense, shall provide to each of the Chief and his spouse (i) an orthodontic benefit in the amount of ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS per

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year of coverage; and (ii) an optical benefit in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS of coverage per year.

After the Chief has been retired for five (5) years, the Borough, at its sole cost and expense, shall provide to each of the Chief and his spouse (i) an orthodontic benefit in the amount of ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$1,500.00) DOLLARS per year of coverage; and (ii) an optical benefit in the amount of ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS per year of coverage.

In order to receive reimbursement in connection with the orthodontic and optical benefits described above, the Chief shall submit receipts to the Borough Administrator.

Effective immediately upon MICHAEL J. CONNER's retirement as Chief, the Borough, at its sole cost and expense, shall provide the Chief and his spouse with health insurance coverage under the New Jersey State Health Benefits Plan currently now in effect identical to the coverage for the Chief and his spouse that shall be in effect just prior to the Chief's retirement, and this post-retirement health insurance coverage shall continue (i) as to the Chief, until the Chief turns 65 and until the Chief becomes eligible for Medicare type A and type B coverage; and (ii) as to the Chief's spouse, until the time that she turns 65 and until she becomes eligible for Medicare type A and type B coverage;

When the Chief turns 65 and becomes eligible for Medicare coverage (and at the later time when the Chief's spouse turns 65 and becomes eligible for Medicare coverage), the Borough, at its sole cost and expense, shall:

- (1) Provide the Chief and his spouse with Medicare, Part B premium coverage when the Chief turns 65 for the rest of the Chief's life and for the rest of his spouse's life; and
- (2) Reimburse the Chief for any and all costs incurred by the Chief in connection with the Chief's purchase of Medicare supplemental ("MediGap") insurance coverage for himself and his spouse. The Borough's reimbursement of all costs for MediGap coverage for the Chief and his spouse shall be in effect throughout the later of the Chief's lifetime and the lifetime of his spouse. On each occasion that reimbursement in connection with the foregoing is sought, the Chief and/or his spouse shall provide the

Borough with reasonable proof of such MediGap insurance purchase prior to the Borough making the reimbursement, and the Borough shall make the reimbursement within fifteen (15) days of its receipt of the proof of the MediGap insurance purchase.

With regard to the time interval between the date on which the Chief turns 65 and the later of the time that either he dies or his spouse dies: (i) if the Chief dies and his widow then remarries, then from and after such remarriage the Borough shall no longer provide the foregoing coverage for the woman who, prior to her remarriage, was the Chief's widow; or (ii) if the Chief and the Chief's spouse divorce each other, then from and after the divorce, the Borough shall no longer provide the foregoing coverage for the Chief's divorced spouse.

POST-RETIREMENT COMPENSATION FOR ASSISTANCE AND INVOLVEMENT IN LITIGATION WITH RESPECT TO THE BOROUGH

If (i) at the time of the Chief's retirement the Chief is a named defendant in pending litigation involving the Borough; (ii) after the Chief retires a litigation is then commenced which names MICHAEL J. CONNER as a defendant by virtue of his service as Chief; or (iii) after retirement, MICHAEL J. CONNER is called to give a deposition or be a witness in a litigation involving his service as Chief, the Borough shall reasonably compensate the Chief as an independent contractor at the rate of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS per hour for any time spent by him in connection with such matters, including travel time, and for his reasonable travel and subsistence costs.

GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

The Chief shall present any grievance within five (5) working dates after arising to the Administrator. The Chief may present the grievance verbally or in writing. Failure to report a grievance within such time shall be deemed as a waiver of the grievance. In the event of a settlement or ruling that results in a determination of monetary liability, such liability shall not exceed more than thirty working days prior to the date the grievance was first presented in writing. The Administrator will communicate the

decision to the Chief within five (5) working days. The Administrator's decision in will be deemed final unless the Chief files an appeal with the Governing Body within five (5) days of receipt of the Administrator's decision.

If the Chief is not satisfied with the decision of the Administrator, he must submit a written grievance to the Governing Body within five (5) days of receipt of the Administrator's decision detailing the facts and the relief requested. After consulting the Labor Attorney, as appropriate, the governing body will render a written decision. Said decision will be rendered by the governing body within thirty (30) days upon receipt of the Chief's appeal.

The Governing Body's decision will be deemed final unless the Chief files an appeal with the New Jersey Superior Court within forty-five (45) days of receipt of the Governing Body's decision.

The forty-five (45) day period shall run from receipt of a letter from the Governing Body, or its representative, or from the date of the Resolution memorializing the Governing Body's decision. Failure on the part of the Chief to appeal within the said period of time shall be deemed a waiver of such appeal and the Governing Body's decision will be final.

MISCELLANEOUS

All the benefits, rights, and obligations inuring to the members of the Union by virtue of any agreement between the Borough and the Union, shall inure to the benefit of the Chief, except as otherwise provided in this Agreement. This provision, however, shall not be interpreted as to afford the Chief any rights pursuant to Public Law, 1968, c. 303, N.J.S.A. 34:13A-1, et seq., as amended; nor shall it be interpreted that the Chief is a member of the Union.

GOVERNING LAW

The terms of performance under this Agreement shall be subordinate to and governed by the laws of the State of New Jersey.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This instrument contains the entire Agreement of the parties respecting the employment of the Chief, and there are no representations, warranties, or commitments, except as set forth herein. This Agreement may be amended only by an instrument in writing executed by the parties hereto.

HEADINGS

Sections and other headings contained in this employment Agreement are for reference purposes only and shall not effect in any way the meaning or interpretation of this agreement.

SAVINGS CLAUSE

Should any valid federal or state law or final determination of any court or administrative agency affect any provision of this Agreement, the provision or provisions so affected shall be automatically conformed to the law or determination and otherwise the Agreement shall continue in full force and effect. Nothing contained in this agreement is intended and shall not be construed as a waiver of any right or benefit to which the Chief or the Employer may be entitled to by law.

TERM & RENEWAL

This Agreement shall be in full force and effect as of the 1st day of August, 2016, which is the date on which the Chief first assumed his duties as Chief, and this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect up to, and including, December 31, 2023. Thus, the date on which this Agreement effectively commences (its "commencement date") is August 1, 2016, notwithstanding that this Agreement is entered into on a date after August 1, 2016. In light of the foregoing, any shortfall in

compensation arising as a result of the delay in entering into this Agreement shall be paid promptly following the parties' entry into the Agreement. In the event that a successor agreement to this Agreement is not executed prior to January 1, 2024, then all the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until such successor agreement is reached.

The Borough will be entitled to terminate this Agreement for "cause". "Cause" shall mean: a) dishonesty, fraud or willful misconduct in the performance of duties or breach of duty of loyalty to the Borough; b) indictment for and conviction of, or guilty plea of a plea of no contest to, any felony or misdemeanor or offense of moral turpitude; c) willful failure to follow the written directives of the Borough or material breach of this Agreement.

RESOLUTION OF THE DUMONT BOROUGH COUNCIL ENDORSING AN ADOPTED HOUSING ELEMENT AND FAIR SHARE PLAN IN FURTHERANCE OF SETTLEMENT OF DECLARATORY JUDGMENT ACTION AND SEEKING JUDGMENT OF COMPLIANCE FROM SUPERIOR COURT OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dumont filed a Declaratory Judgment Action (hereafter 'DJ Action') on June 30, 2015, entitled <u>IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE BOROUGH OF DUMONT</u>, bearing docket number BER-L-6065-15, pursuant to an Order of the Supreme Court of the State of New Jersey <u>IN THE MATTER OF THE ADOPTION OF N.J.A.C. 5:96 AND 5:97 BY THE NEW JERSEY COUNCIL ON AFFORDABLE HOUSING</u>, 221 N.J. 1 (2015)(Mount Laurel IV); and

WHEREAS, a settlement agreement (hereafter 'Agreement') was reached in the DJ Action with the lone remaining Intervenor, Fair Share Housing Center, which was deemed fair and reasonable, and in the interest of the protected class by Order of the Honorable William C. Meehan, J.S.C. filed on September 18, 2017 (hereafter 'Order'), and

WHEREAS, the Joint Land Use Board of the Borough of Dumont, Bergen County, State of New Jersey, adopted the Housing Element and Fair Share Plan of the Master Plan consistent with the Agreement on December 26, 2017; and

WHEREAS, a true copy of the resolution of the Joint Land Use Board adopting the Housing Element is attached pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C</u>. 5:96-2.2(a)2; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is required to take certain prescribed actions in furtherance of the Order.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the Borough of Dumont, Bergen County, State of New Jersey, hereby endorses the Housing Element and Fair Share Plan as adopted by the Borough of Dumont Joint Land Use Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governing Body of Borough of Dumont, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 52:27D-301 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 5:96-3.2(a), and the mandates of Mount Laurel IV, authorizes and directs that in conjunction with the Housing Element and Fair Share Plan, and companion enabling legislation to be enacted concurrently herewith, a Motion for a Judgment of Compliance and Repose by filed forthwith in the Superior Court of New Jersey under the Docket number of the DJ Action for further processing; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be served upon all parties on the official Service List for the DJ Action within 7 days of the adoption hereof, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of this endorsement of the Housing Element and Fair Share Plan shall be published in a newspaper of countywide circulation pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:96-3.5 within seven days of the adoption hereof and that a copy of this resolution, the adopted Housing Element and Fair Share Plan and all supporting documentation shall be made available for public inspection at the Borough of Dumont Municipal Clerk's office located at 80 W. Madison Avenue, Dumont, NJ 07628, during the hours of 9AM to 4:30PM on Monday through Friday and the Borough website: dumontnj.gov, for a period of 45 days following the date of publication of the legal notice pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:96-3.5.
