- 2. Review Prior Meeting Minutes -- Accepted after review (noted that quorum wasn't at March meeting but action items were voted by full Commission after the meeting via email.
- 3. Discussion of homeowner issues/questions (if any)

Several issues currently being addressed by DSTC (Tom not at meeting)

Highwood: a branch came down discussed that safety issues give homeowners latitude if needed to proceed w/o inspection. A homeowner had Bergenfield Tree Co give estimate for a declining tree and then said tree next to it also should come down. Ray explained that this opportunistic approach should be a red flag. Ray will inspect. Homeowner wants replacement trees.

Veronica Greco: has a tree in Memorial Park for father (memorial tree was planted over 20 years ago family cared/cares for the tree and it's doing well). Now mother- Mrs. Claire Charlotte Greco, has passed. DSTC voted unanimously (Ray motion to vote/Tanya 2nd motion) to grant that the memorial tree for her can be placed on walkway in Memorial Park. Mrs. Claire Charlotte Greco was a veteran (worked in kitchens during WWII) also wife of vet so VERY appropriate to have tree to honor her service. Wants a Service Berry Tree. DSTC will manage and get tree and plant tree. Greco family will pay and get plaque similar to Father's plaque.

 - Award of Merit for 2018: Lupardi's Nursery
 - Art contest: Tanya reported art contest 77 entries, 18 Ribbons: 10 winners, several classes did group projects from the elementary schools; 7 participants in yarn bombing; we will ask



- students to take art after Arbor Day; those that don't take art we will return to schools
- Yarn Bombing: will have a contest- all voted to give \$20 Michael's gift card to winner proceeds from money collected for activity
- Carole will ask Sue Connelly to put the Arbor Day event notice on BH sign on Washington Avenue
- Carole Stewart: has asked and plans for a county executive and/or freeholder to come to the arbor day event—Jim Tedesco or someone from his office will be there
- plant a tree Ray has been in touch w/ nursery—Smoke Tree is the 'wish' but may not get it. He will get the best tree he can for the day
- Ray has draft of agenda for the day
- Bricks: had 3 bricks this year including one for Lupardi (will imprint: Lupardi Nursery 2018) but bricks won't be ready for Arbor Day. Maybe have on a table.

- 9. Events; Concerts at the Gazebo, other summer programs all on schedule. Will have 4 concerts. Work on this after Arbor day

10. Tree Maintenance – discussed insurance requirements for any crane operators. Dumont's truck not working so we call out to Bergenfield or Haworth.

- DPW Acting Superintendent: Anthony Schiraldi DPW: Bill Ebenack (sp?) retired. We are very happy to welcome Anthony and Dennis as our tree guy—accolades all around
- Ray and Bill spoke to DPW regarding Arboretum parking lot striping and paving and getting

bumpers. More bushes were run over by trucks/cars parking on West Shore.

- Dennis is going for CTE training and certification
- Discussion of truck—Carole knows we need capital investment.
- Town budget is in, we don't get a new tree truck this year as many other items rose to the top of the list (fire and police equipment) Budget is stressed...tight.
- Carole will look into a Crane ordinance and insurance requirements
- Town Grants: Working on getting \$\$\$. Discussion of matching grants and how best to get the money. Matching can be in kind but Ray was working w/ Peter Banos—Millennium Grants—and it was difficult to justify the in-kind work for the money we want for planting (\$12K??). Will investigate further.
 - o Grants available for tree planting and tree inventory

11. Tree permits

- many have been received. Tom is working on them w/ Ray and Abbie. After storms slight backlog.
- We are pleased with Rebecca and Colleen thanks to them in a very busy office --in the Building department handling requests.

12. Update from FOTST -

- fundraising, activities and projects: FOTST is awarding a scholarship (3rd year in a row) to a DSH graduating senior) Award \$\$ and recipient is confidential, the committee (Tanya, Abbie, Rachel, Bill Z) met and determined the winner. WE will present scholarship on June 6th Senior Award night. Sally gave check to Rachel who gave it to Bill Z. to give to Terry Stanek at DHS.
