A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF DUMONT IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE JOINT LAND USE BOARD OF THE BOROUGH OF DUMONT TO CONDUCT A PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY WITHIN THE BOROUGH FOR POTENTIAL REDEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6 authorizes the governing body of any municipality, by resolution, to have its Joint Land Use Board conduct a preliminary investigation to determine whether an area of the municipality is an "area in need of redevelopment" pursuant to the criteria contained in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Dumont consider it to be in the

best interest of the Borough to have the Joint Land Use Board conduct such an investigation regarding certain property located in the Borough known as D'Angelo Farms, which consists of two parcels of property identified as Block 212, Lot 20 and Block 215, Lot 1, as shown on the official Tax Map of the Borough of Dumont (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council believes the Property is potentially valuable for contributing to, serving, and protecting the public health safety and welfare and for the promotion of smart growth within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary investigation will be designed to evaluate the area to determine whether designation of the Property as an "area in need of redevelopment" is appropriate and in conformance with the statutory criteria contained in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5; and

WHEREAS, in the event that the investigation results in the designation of the Property as an "area in need of redevelopment," the redevelopment area determination shall authorize the Borough of Dumont to use all those powers provided by the Legislature for use in a redevelopment area other than the use of eminent domain.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Dumont, they being the Governing Body thereof, as follows:

- 1. The Joint Land Use Board of the Borough of Dumont is hereby directed to conduct a preliminary investigation to determine whether the aforementioned Property, or any portions thereof, constitute an "area in need of redevelopment" according to the criteria set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5;
- 2. The Joint Land Use Board of the Borough of Dumont is hereby directed to study the area known as Block 212, Lot 20 and Block 215, Lot 1; to develop a map reflecting the boundaries of the proposed redevelopment area; to provide public notice and conduct public hearings pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:6; and to draft a report/Resolution to the Mayor and Council containing its findings; and
- 3. The results of such preliminary investigation shall be submitted to the Mayor and Council for review and approval in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq.; and
- 4. The power of Eminent Domain over the property pursuant to N.J.S.A. 20:3-1 et seq. And 40A:12A-8 will not be exercised by the Borough in connection with this investigation or any designation of the property as an area in need of redevelopment.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

RESOLUTION BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF DUMONT AS INSURED BY THE MUNICIPAL EXCESS LIABILITY JOINT INSURANCE FUND

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dumont ("Borough") was named as a defendant in the case of <u>Joseph Rizza v. Borough of Dumont</u>, et al, in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Bergen County Law Division, Docket No. BER-L-8825-13 in which the Borough was represented by defense counsel appointed by the Municipal Excess Liability Joint Insurance Fund ("MEL"), the Borough's insurer; and

WHEREAS, this matter has reached a settlement in the amount of \$275,000; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of its policy with the MEL, the Borough is responsible for a co-pay and deductible totaling \$65,580.57 in connection with the settlement of this matter; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is experiencing, as are other municipalities in the State, cash flow problems and the Borough, while fully recognizing its obligation to pay the sum of \$65,580.57 as its part of the overall settlement, is not in a liquid position to make such a payment at this point in time; and

WHEREAS, the MEL has agreed to allow the Borough to repay the sum of \$65,580.57 to the MEL over a three (3) year period; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has agreed to reimburse the MEL in three (3) installments of \$21,860.19 plus interest, with the first payment being made to the MEL on or before January 1, 2017 and subsequent payments to be made annually thereafter until the full amount has been repaid to the MEL, together with interest equal to the rate of interest the MEL is currently receiving on its investments, which fluctuates, but which, at the moment is .87%. The annual payment of \$21,860.19 per year shall be on the unpaid principal; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to resolve this matter and acknowledges that its obligation for its co-pay and deductible in connection with this matter is \$65,580.57, none of which is to be paid for by the MEL other than by way of the arrangement authorized by this Resolution which involves an advance of funds to be repaid by the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough fully understands that if it resigns or fails to renew its membership or for any other reason is no longer a member of the Bergen County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund or the MEL before the entire \$65,580.57 is repaid to the MEL, all outstanding monies due and owing to the MEL, including principal and interest, shall be paid to the MEL on the January 1st of the year the Borough is no longer a member of the Bergen County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund or the MEL.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Dumont as follows:

- 1. The Borough does hereby approve the settlement of the matter entitled <u>Joseph</u> Rizza v. Borough of Dumont, et al. Said settlement has been paid by the MEL to the plaintiff.
- 2. The Borough agrees and stipulates that its obligation under the MEL and Bergen County Joint Insurance Fund's policies is to pay \$65,580.57 towards co-pays and deductible.
- 3. The Borough agrees that the MEL shall be reimbursed by the Borough in three (3) annual installments of \$21,860.19 plus interest, with the first payment being made to the MEL on or before January 1, 2017 and subsequent payments to be made annually thereafter until the full amount has been repaid to the MEL, together with interest equal to the rate of interest the MEL is currently receiving on its investments, which

fluctuates, but which, at the moment is .87%. The annual payment of \$21,860.19 per year shall be accompanied by an interest payment on the unpaid principal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a Repayment Agreement from the Borough of to the MEL incorporating the terms and conditions of this Resolution.
